



Are you Eligible for Deferred Action of Childhood Arrivals (DACA)?

- Did you enter the US before your 16th birthday?
- At the time of filing will you be over 15 years old and younger than 31 years old?

If you are under 15 years old, and you are currently in removal proceeding or have a final order of removal, you may be eligible. If you are over 31 years old you are not eligible.
- Were you physically present in the US on June 15, 2012?
- Are you currently enrolled in school, have graduated from High School, or are currently enrolled in a GED program or have obtained your GED? Or are you a veteran of the US Armed Forces?
- Have you remained in the US (not traveled internationally for long periods of time) since you entered the country?
- On June 15, 2012, were you in **UNLAWFUL** immigration status?
- Do you **NOT** pose a threat to US national security or US public safety?

You must not have been convicted of a felony or a “significant” misdemeanor or, must not have been convicted of three or more misdemeanors.
- You have **NEVER** been arrested, stopped, or detained by the police or immigration?

**If you answered YES to the above questions, then you might
be eligible for DACA.**
